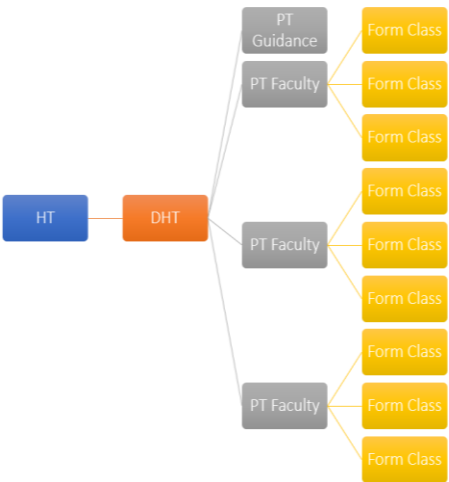
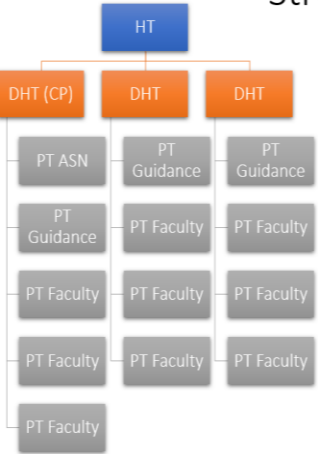


The Role of The Guidance Teacher

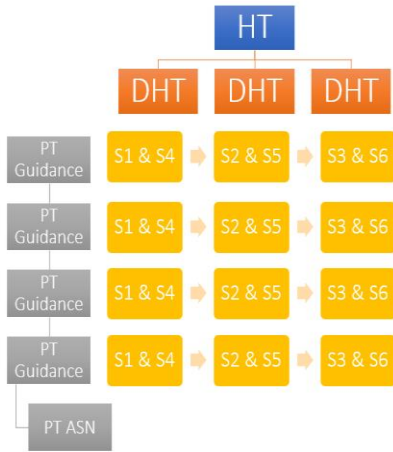
- How the role has evolved over time.

1930 – Junior Secondary Education	1955 – Scottish Secondary School Guidance	1963 – Glasgow schools introduced guidance structures
1965 – Local Authorities appoint staff (Career teachers, House Masters and Year Group Heads)	1968 – Guidance in Scottish Secondary Schools. Orange Paper.	1971 – The Structure of Promoted Posts in Secondary Schools in Scotland (Green Paper)
1974 – All Local Authorities had Guidance Structures	1976 – Job Descriptions introduced	1986 – More than Feelings of Concern **First Line Guidance
1996 – HMI Inspection of Guidance	1996 – Scottish Young People Survey	1998 – Making the Difference : A GTC Report on the Professional Needs of Guidance Teachers

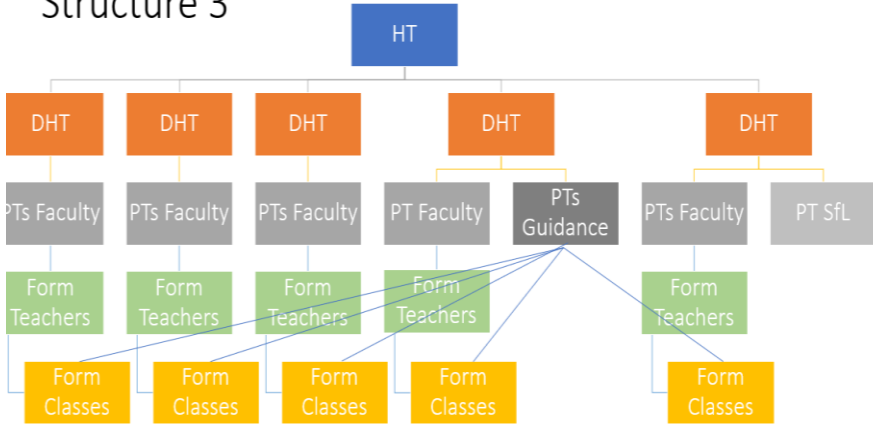

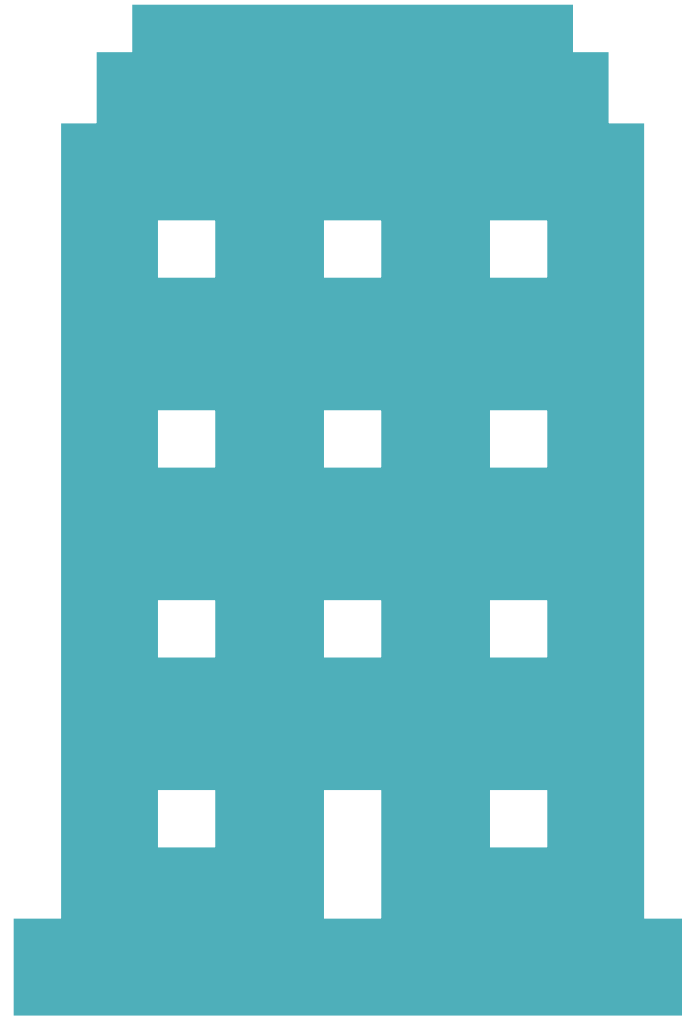

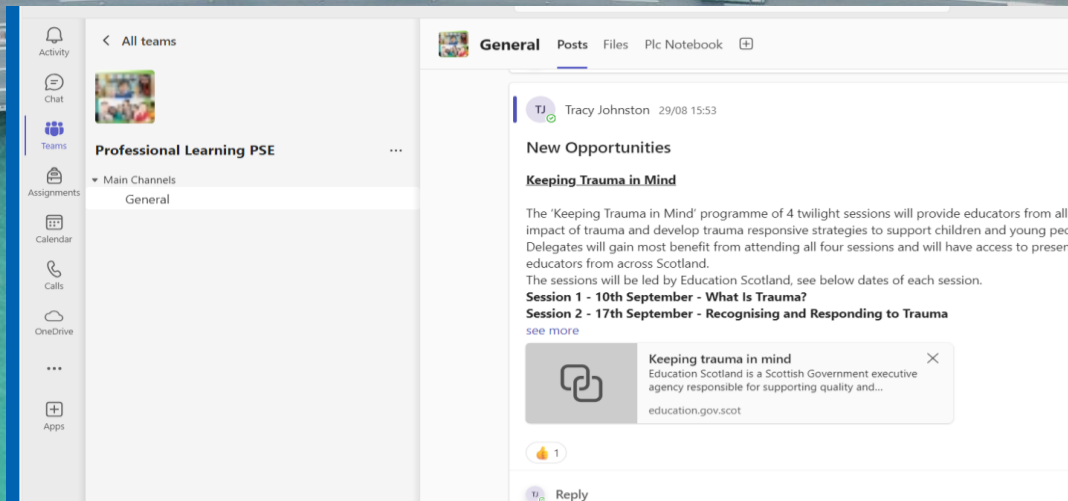
