











 How the role has evolved over time. 0 – Junior Secondary Education

1955 – Scottish Secondary School Guidance 1963 – Glasgow school: introduced guidance structures

1965 – Local Authorities appoint staff (Career seachers, House Masters and Year Group Heads)

1968 – Guidance in Scottish Secondary Schools. Orange Paper.

1971 – The Structure of Promoted Posts in Secondary Schools in Scotland (Green Paper)

1974 – All Local Authorities had Guidance Structures

1976 – Job Descriptio introduced 1986 – More than Feelings of Concern **First Line Guidance

1996 – HMI Inspection of Guidance



PTs Guidance have no formal line management responsibilities PSE is not a subject. (<u>McCrone</u> 2003).




